



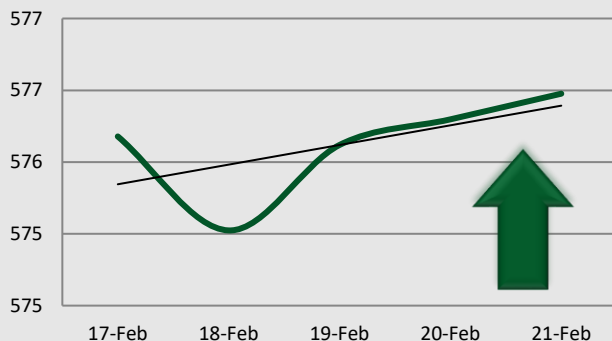

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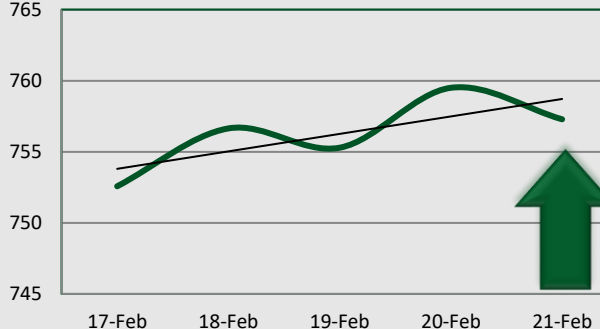
➤ Despite Israel's threats of retaliation against Hamas for the return of deceased hostages, oil traders remained largely indifferent, leading crude prices to drop over \$2 per barrel on Friday. Brent fell to \$74.43, while WTI declined to \$70.40, contributing to weekly losses. Traders focused on geopolitical stability, including a Gaza ceasefire and potential Ukraine-Russia peace, with some interpreting U.S. pressure on Ukraine as a sign of easing sanctions on Russia. However, U.S. officials reaffirmed that sanctions on Russia would remain unless Moscow's behavior changed. Meanwhile, market uncertainty persisted due to OPEC+ possibly delaying an output increase and concerns over Kazakh pipeline disruptions. (Ship& Bunker, February 21, 2024)

➤ In maritime advancements, the American Bureau of Shipping (ABS) approved a nuclear-powered container ship design from HD Korea Shipbuilding & Offshore Engineering, bringing nuclear propulsion closer to commercial shipping. The 15,000 TEU vessel will use a molten salt reactor (MSR) with a supercritical carbon dioxide system for power generation, meeting class requirements. ABS CEO Christopher Wiernicki emphasized that nuclear energy is essential for achieving net-zero emissions in shipping. ABS is also working with the U.S. Department of Energy to study barriers to nuclear adoption. The approval marks a significant step toward commercial nuclear-powered vessels, a technology currently dominated by naval ships. (Ship& Bunker, February 21, 2024)
