Top stories of the week

- ➤ Shell forecasts that global LNG bunker demand will reach 16 million mt annually by 2030, with container ships accounting for approximately 11 million mt, supported by an expanding LNG-fueled vessel order book and growing bunkering infrastructure. Bio-LNG production is expected to reach 18 billion cubic metres (bcm) by the decade's end, particularly in North America, offering a cleaner alternative for dual-fuel vessels. In 2024, LNG cargo trade hit 407 million mt, though growth slowed to its lowest rate in a decade. Demand surged in Asia, driven by lower prices in China and increased Indian imports amid extreme summer temperatures. (Ship& Bunker, February 27, 2024)
- > The European Commission has launched the Clean Industrial Deal to scale up green fuel production and decarbonize industries shipping, backed by over €100 billion in funding. The initiative aims to lower energy costs, enhance clean-tech manufacturing, and ensure a robust supply of low-carbon fuels, with strong support from shipping groups such as ECSA and Danish Shipping. Key measures include the Sustainable Transport Investment Plan, which will allocate funds, including €9 billion from shipping ETS revenues, toward fuel production. However, stakeholders stress the need for a clear strategy to bridge the price gap between fossil and cleaner fuels, warning that without sufficient supply, climate-neutral shipping remains unattainable.
