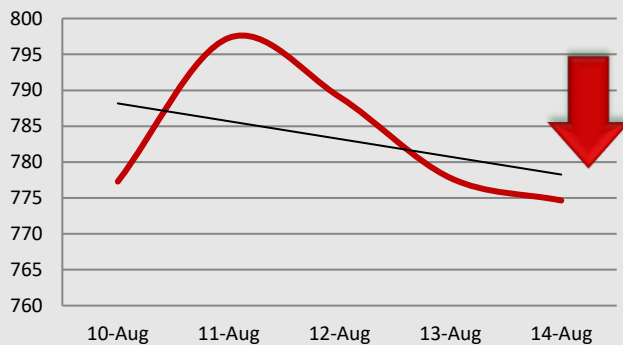


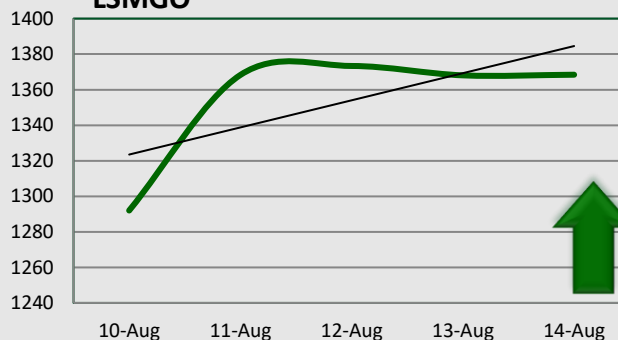

## Top stories of the week

➤ Bunker demand at the world's two key hubs picked up in July, though both remained below year-ago levels. Singapore's conventional and biofuel sales rose 1.3% month on month to a four-month high of 4.67 million mt, a third consecutive monthly gain and the strongest since March 2026, when demand surged at the start of the Iran war, but still 4.2% below July 2025. VLSFO sales climbed 5.9% to 2.33 million mt while HSFO slipped 4.4% to 1.95 million mt, distillates gained 4.2% to 359,600 mt, and biofuel blends rose 5.3% to 39,500 mt yet stayed 67% lower on the year, with B100 falling to 1,360 mt. LNG bunkering jumped 41.5% year on year to 58,690 mt, and bunker calls reached 3,675 even as average stem size eased to 1,271.6 mt. Fujairah rebounded more dramatically, with sales surging 167.2% from June's record low to 231,865 m3, led by a 314.8% jump in 380 CST VLSFO to 143,487 m3, though volumes were still 63.8% below July 2025 as Hormuz traffic stayed depressed. Fujairah's average VLSFO price fell to \$762.5/mt from \$1,116/mt, while Singapore averaged \$755/mt and the G20-VLSFO Index reached \$760/mt. Show more lines.
